

USF EAN Diver Certification (Nitrox Diver Certification)

(all the information in this publication is subject to change)

The USF Campus Recreation Center sponsors a Nitrox Diver certification class **open to the general public**. The class culminates with a nationally recognized Nitrox Diver certification issued by the National Association of Underwater Instructors (NAUI) In order to receive this certification all certification requirements **MUST** be met.

The course is a single night course. Typically it meets for 4 hours in the evening. As per NAUI standards it is lecture only (no pool sessions). Although not required it is strongly recommended that the lecture be followed by 2 open water dives where Nitrox is used. The USF program will provide the equipment for these dives as long as they are scheduled in advance and the equipment is available.

Prerequisites: each student must hold a scuba certification of Open Water or greater in any nationally recognized scuba training agency.

Necessary Equipment: a simple calculator is necessary for the lecture work

Class size: Since this is a lecture only class the size is only limited by the class. Typically, there is no limit.
